SOLUS



Solus is a globally recognized artist whose vibrant spray-paint based works have appeared on walls, canvas, sculpture, and large-scale public murals across Europe, North America, and Asia. For over a decade, his compelling visuals have communicated messages of positivity, unity, and cultural exchange that resonate worldwide.

In 2017, Solus served as a National Trailblazer (Ambassador) for Culture Ireland, representing Irish creative culture internationally. The following year he was nominated as one of only five Irish artists for the Irish Central Creativity and Arts Awards for his impact on the streets of New York. During his time in the US, Solus collaborated with John "Crash" Matos, a pioneer within the graffiti movement from the subways into galleries.

His work is held in the collections of major cultural figures, including Bono (U2) and Christina Aguilera. He has partnered with global brands and institutions including Jameson, Sony, Adidas, Dublin City Council, Universal Studios, RTE, PETA.org, Trinity College, Today FM, and Vodafone.



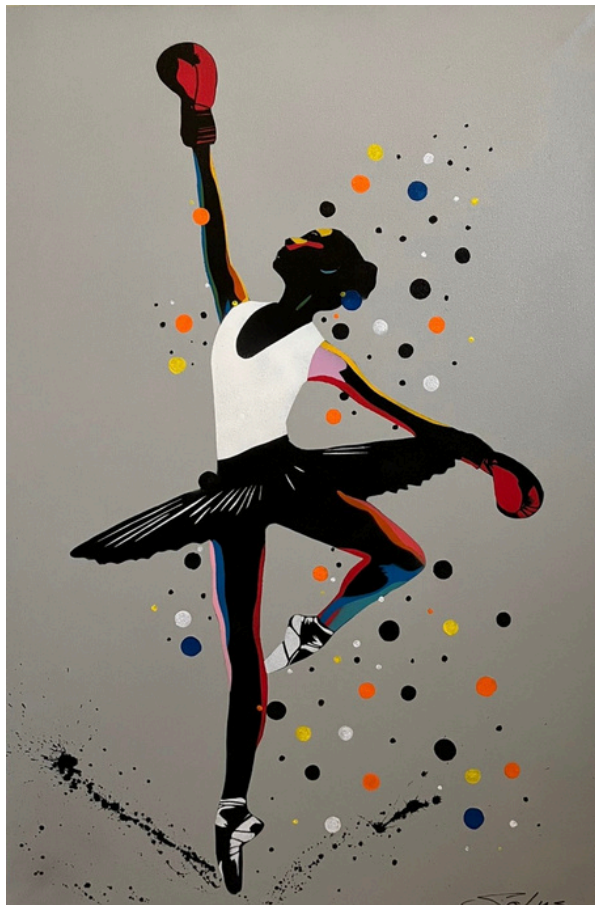

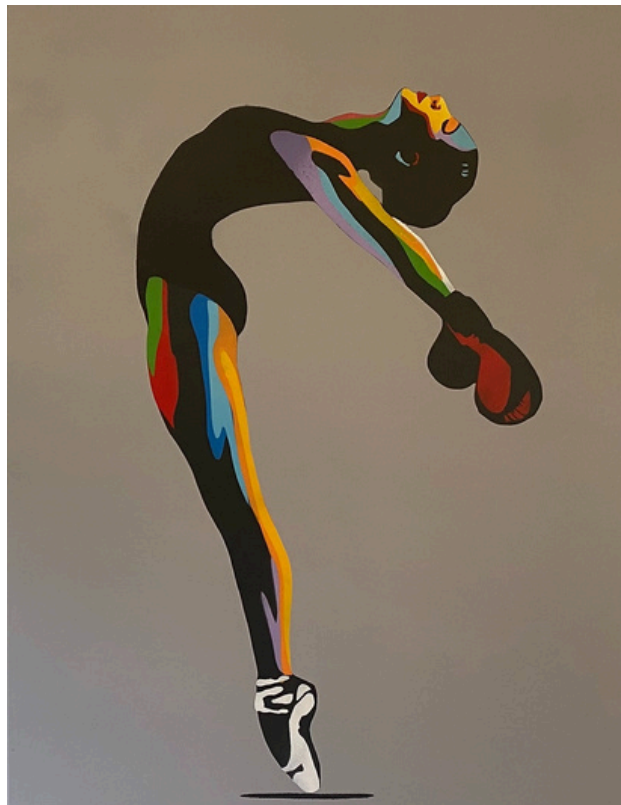

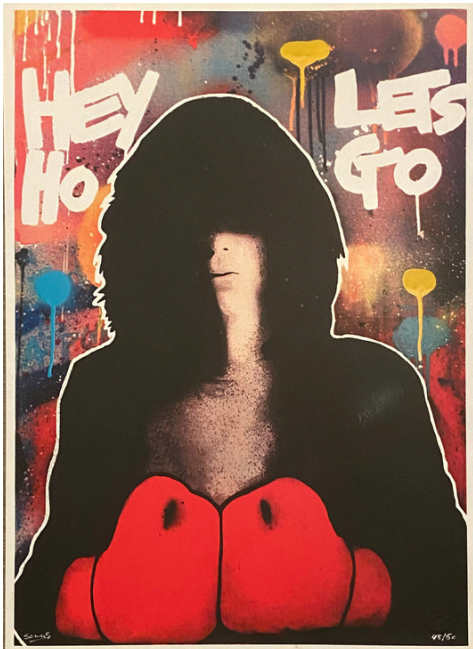

LULU



Laura “Lulu” Reich is a curator, art dealer, entrepreneur, and former gallery owner, celebrated for her dedication to the personal impact of art and its transformative power on spaces and communities. With over 15 years of experience in the luxury market, Lulu has worked across fashion, fine art galleries, auction houses, and their corporate offices in New York, Chicago, and Connecticut. Her work is centered on sharing the stories of creatives and fostering meaningful connections between artists, collectors, and the public, believing that art is a powerful vehicle for authentic conversations about life and culture.

In 2015, Lulu opened her first gallery in the East Village, New York. In 2022, she founded Collect With Lulu, an independent art dealing and curation business. A notable highlight of her career was launching the Highwood International Mural Festival in 2024. This groundbreaking project introduced the city’s first large-scale murals, bringing together over 12 artists to transform Highwood into a vibrant canvas of public art and marking a significant cultural milestone for the community she loves.

Lulu champions contemporary, graffiti, and street artists, collaborating with creatives from both the U.S. and internationally. Born and raised in Highland Park, IL, and now based in New York City, she continues to create impactful art experiences for both private collections and public spaces.

KOZ

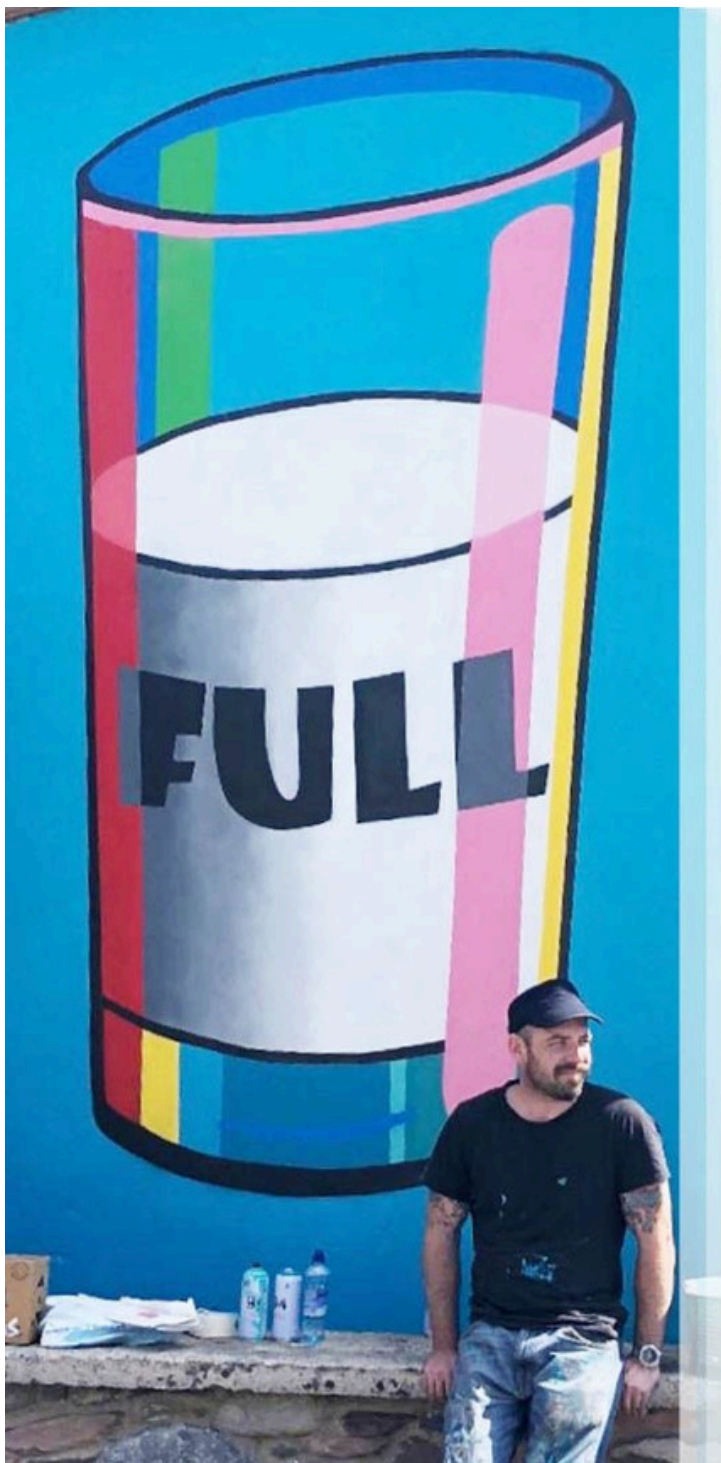


Silvertuna Studios is the brainchild and production arm of filmmaker and graffiti artist Koz. Born and raised on Long Island, New York, Koz grew up surrounded by art, with artist-parents who fully supported his creative endeavors. While comic books and Michelangelo's works ignited his love for drawing, it was the graffiti he encountered while skating in Brooklyn, Queens, and Manhattan that set the trajectory for his artistic life. As a teenager, Koz was captivated by the work of CAP, JA, PACE & CEES SWK, FIB, JEST, EASY, TRACY 168, KEL 1ST, and QUIK, among others.

Professionally, Koz's career took off when he began obsessively filming himself and fellow skateboarders during the early VHS, Hi8, and Mini DV recording days. In his late 20s, Koz joined the Manhattan-based production company Vidiots Inc., where he met his filmmaking mentor, Jeff Fisher, a thirteen-time Emmy Award winner and now co-owner of Silvertuna Studios. Within four years, Koz worked on over 40 TV shows for more than 20 networks.

After leaving Vidiots, Koz joined CBS as an Avid Media Composer engineer and photographer, with his work showcased throughout their New York City headquarters. Later, he moved to NBC to work on "Talk Stoop" as a camera operator and set photographer, earning an Emmy nomination for his camera work.

Koz launched Silvertuna Studios, a Queens-based production company. He premiered two episodes of his six-part series about NYC graffiti artists, *The Blackbook Diaries*, at the Angelika Theater and continues to work on the remaining episodes. Koz also curates art shows and collaborates with graffiti legends like EASY, Chris RWK, Al Diaz (SAMO), Shepard Fairey OBEY, skateboarders Bam Margera and Zered Bassett, as well as actress Kathrine Narducci. In 2024 Koz co-curated the first Highwood International Mural Festival followed by a documentary covering the journey. His ultimate goal is to have one of his films premiere worldwide and continue to contribute to the world of art.
